**West Hills Sports Center/Bischoff Fields to Get Parking Lot & Street Signal**  
***Join us for the groundbreaking across from the ball fields***

- WHAT:** The groundbreaking of a parking lot to accommodate overflow parking needs at the West Hills Sports Center.
- WHEN:** Monday, November 21st, 9:30am
- WHERE:** Directly across the street from the West Hills Ball Fields

- PROJECT:** The development of the parking lot is a Proposition K/Proposition 40 funded project. The scope of work is to develop a parking lot for the park and a street signal/pedestrian crosswalk on Valley Circle Blvd. in West Hills. The parking lot will have 62 stalls, a gravel surface, concrete wheel stops, perimeter fencing, bio-swale with planting, and solar light fixtures for security. On the City Right of Way there will be a Smart crosswalk, a driveway, pedestrian ramps, a traffic signal, and signage. The estimated total project cost is \$604,288. The project has been in the works for several years and Councilman Zine is pleased that it will improve pedestrian safety for those visiting the West Hills Ball Fields and Recreation Center, and that nearby facilities will also benefit from the increased parking.
